3. Program/Agency Updates

LCDSS updates — Social Services were awarded a grant to cover a Child Welfare Case Manager for 2026. This employee will provide intensive supervision for our high-risk youth in the community. The goal is by having this staff member regularly following up with the youth, we can reduce the amount of money spent on out-of-home placements. Vape detectors were purchased and given to the schools in our County. Stacy and Sheri mentioned that they were not aware that Tomahawk received any. Jessi will reach out to Wendell to confirm where they are at. A mini-grant through the Opioid Task Force will be released soon and will be to help with strengthening families projects and community education programs. Once the application for these funds is complete, it will be sent out to the group.

Tomahawk School District — Love & Logic started and will run through November. They are looking at some events for spring - Wait Till 8 & Screen Free Week. The thought is to maybe to a Screen Free Day and start small and get feedback. Tomahawk's AMC committee would benefit from having a social worker present at their meetings. Jessi, Sheri and Stacy will schedule a meeting to discuss.

PRMS - Parent Teacher Conferences are coming up and they will have "Hidden In Plain Sight" set up for parents to walk through.

Big Brother's Big Sister's — BBBS has a successful 'Big' recruitment this fall. Cheryl explained the process with matches and what is required from 'Big's' each week and how it works. Bigs can now complete the application digitally. They are still in the process of getting Littles applications digital.

Health Department- Lexi stated that the Health Department received a grant for carbon monoxide detectors and will be offering them to residents. They are also working on doing a focus group in Tomahawk that would have a discussion around mental health and nutrition. Specifically on the barriers families are experiencing and what they would like to see in the community; and also how to engage with those and get them to attend events.
