3. Aspirus Health Community Health Needs Assessment

The team discussed Aspirus Community Health Assessment results as presented by Beversdorf, which included scale of issue, disparities, community momentum, community alignment, control and capacity for each proposed priority — Mental Health, Community Resources for Aging Population and Healthy Lifestyles. The team reviewed other trends, such as medical access, rising medical costs, dental care challenges, and social media literacy. This review is part of Aspirus 3 year requirement to conduct a community health assessment and implementation plan. The next step will be for Aspirus to develop an action plan.
