We normally do not do storm tree cleanup for the Towns.

Lyskawa asked for more information on brine usage. Per Bishop, normally, in a storm like we just had, the brine is not effective because there was so much rain and moisture.

Wickman asked about how the frost is looking. Per Bishop the range is from zero to eighteen inches.
